DEEP TALKS

Divide participants into pairs and seat them at a table or comfortable space for reflection. Provide each pair with one of the 4 Ikigai cards, and invite each pair to exchange their responses, spending a similar amount of time on each of the four Ikigai questions.

The game ends when the participants have talked in depth about each of the four cards. At the end, the whole group is brought together and the pair is invited to present their conclusions to the audience.

CARD EXCHANGE

Gather your group and give an Ikigai question card to each participant. Encourage them to pair up and take turns answering each other's questions. As they finish, have them exchange cards and continue meeting with new partners.


Once all participants have had a chance to answer all the questions or the set up time has expired, bring the group together to wrap up the exercise and reflect on their newfound connections.

ART GALLERY

Give a card to each participant and invite them in groups of four to create a painting that visually answers their question. When the drawings are ready, invite them to share their artwork with the rest of the group and explain their motives. At the end of the activity, you can create a gallery with the results.

SPEED DATING

Distribute two cards to each participant and place them in two circles, one outer and one inner, with the same number of participants facing each other. Each question needs between one to three minutes to be answered in the pair, and at the end of the time, rotate the participants randomly to answer several different questions.








What did you dream of for your future adult life when you were a child?






What personalities inspire you and make you feel like you can achieve everything?






What did you use to play when you were a child for hours without getting bored?






If you had all the time in the world, what would you do every day?




What's your favorite memory and why does it mean so much to you?






If you could have any superpower, what would it be and why?












What do you think is necessary for business success?






How do you imagine yourself making a profit?






What are your most important values or beliefs and how can you make them shine through a business?






What do you enjoy doing the most, and how could you turn that into a product?






What is a skill or talent that you have that others are willing to pay for?






What are your biggest passions and how could you turn them into a career or business?






What would you do if you had to start a business tomorrow?






Can you think of a time when you helped someone solve a problem?






What have been your biggest successes or achievements in the past?








What do you feel confident about when you think about your future?






What compliments have you received from others that have made you feel proud?






What activities or tasks do you enjoy doing and feel confident about?






What are you proudest of accomplishing in your life?






What comes easy to you that others struggle with?






When have you received recognition for your skills or abilities?






What is one thing a person should learn about you?






What was one of the most ridiculous idea or creation you had as a child?






What are some of the biggest challenges that face your community?






What are some of the unmet needs or problems that you see in the world?






How can you contribute to creating a better future for yourself, your community, and the world?




What kind of changes do you want to see and why is it important to you?






What kind of business would you start if money wasn't a concern and why?






If you could wave a magic wand and solve one problem in the world, what would it be?






If you could have a conversation with any historical figure, who would it be and what would you ask?






If you could invent a new product that would change the world, what would it be?
